Students must complete 5 Law Electives from any LAWS13 or 17 Code subjects.

For the combined program, LAWS13-541 Banking and Financial Law must be taken as one of the five Law Electives.

Students may choose to complete an optional Law Specialisation in one of the following areas:

- Corporate and Commercial Law
- International and Comparative Law
- Media and Technology Law
- Contemporary Legal Issues
- Legal Practice
- Canadian Law and Practice

To be eligible for a specialisation, students must complete a minimum of four (4) of their Law Electives within one of the above areas. Eligible students will receive a Specialisation Certificate at the completion of their Law Degree.
