1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

This Procedure specifies naming conventions for program titles and post-nominals for all award and research programs offered by Bond University and Bond University College. Program title naming conventions are established in accordance with the [AQF Qualifications Issuance Policy](#) and ensure consistent standards are maintained throughout the University.

2. AUDIENCE AND APPLICATION

This Procedure applies to all Academic Programs (refer to the [Academic Programs Policy](#)) and Higher Degree by Research programs (refer to the [Higher Degree by Research Programs Policy](#)) offered by Bond University. This Procedure excludes naming conventions for Non-award Study offerings which are governed by the [Non-award Study Policy](#).

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4. THE PROCEDURE

4.1 Exceptions to this Procedure

Program titles approved prior to the first date of approval of this Procedure are exempt from the principles set out in this Procedure.

4.2 Program Title Naming Principles

Approval of a program title will consider that the title:

- is easily understood by stakeholders, including students, employers and the general community;
- is accurate in its description of the level of award in line with the provisions of the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF);
- normally does not specify any major but the discipline area in which the major falls (e.g., Arts, Business, Health Sciences, Laws, Marketing);
- is consistent and articulates the program title with those being utilised at the higher or lower degree level and within the discipline (e.g., within business programs, the use of Diploma of Business, Bachelor of Business and Master of Business Administration);

- e) avoids duplication with an unrelated discipline;
- f) considers the number of specific program titles in the general academic and professional areas already used by the University;
- g) considers the length of the title and, unless justification is provided, does not exceed a limit of 200 characters (including spaces, hyphens, and commas);
- h) recognises the principal discipline of study with regard to the:
 - i. program objectives and learning outcomes;
 - ii. structure and content of the program;
 - iii. extent of the recruitment or marketing demands for the program title;
 - iv. extent of the professional or employment demands for the program title; and
 - v. alignment with the requirements of any professional accrediting body or other contractual arrangement with a partner organisation;
 - vi. the extent of the use of program titles in the national and international community.

5. PROGRAM TITLE NAMING CONVENTIONS

5.1 Construction of Program Title

The standard construction for a program title is:

- a) the level or category of the award (e.g., Bachelor, Graduate Diploma, Master) followed by
- b) the discipline name (e.g., Health Science, Arts, Design, Laws, Business), and in some cases
- c) a modifier (refer to Clause 1.5.3).

The following information is *not* included in a program title. This information is recorded in the Curriculum Management System (CURMIT) as appropriate.

- Location of study (e.g., Gold Coast, Queensland)
- Study pattern (part-time, full-time)
- Payment arrangements (fee-paying, scholarship)
- Admission standards/requirements (limited work experience; graduate/direct entry)
- Misleading words (e.g., 'credit', 'non-award', 'assessment', 'academic').

5.1.1 Category of Award

The University adopts the following naming conventions for program titles:

5.1.2 Combined Degrees

With respect to combined degrees, for administrative systems, the correct naming convention is to list the degrees in alphabetical order with a forward slash between. For example, Bachelor of Commerce / Bachelor of Laws. When graduating with a combined degree, students do not graduate with one combined degree but receive separate awards and testamurs for each program completed.

5.1.3 Discipline

The discipline name in a program title should be as broad as possible indicating a generic range of cognate disciplines rather than a single, narrow specialisation. Each Faculty and University Academic Unit (UAU)

should specify as few disciplines as possible for its bachelor awards in particular, and where possible any discipline name should become the common denominator for a sequence of levels e.g., DA, BA, MA.

The discipline should normally be either:

- found in the name of a Faculty or UAU (in which case that Faculty or UAU should normally have the control of that field name); or
- associated with accreditation and qualification in a particular profession or occupation (e.g., Architecture, Accounting, Physiotherapy, Psychology, Actuarial Science); or
- associated with a widely recognised academic tradition (e.g., Arts).

The adoption of a new discipline name will normally be limited to:

- requirements for professional accreditation; or
- to identify a specialist program in an approved area; or
- to reflect established practice at benchmarked comparator universities.

5.1.4 Modifiers

There are two types of modifiers which may be used to:

- indicate a particular type of AQF qualification i.e., Professional, Honours;
- assist the University administratively with program components that may not be easily inferred otherwise i.e., Coursework, USEd, 3-year Program, Online, Intensive.

The following list are approved modifiers for use in program titles:

(3-year program)	No
(Online)	No
(Intensive)	No
(Extended)	No

Majors, minors, and specialisations may be listed on academic transcripts but are not normally included on testamurs.

5.2 Exemptions

Where an exemption from these protocols is sought, a case must be put to the Academic Senate through Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) or University Research Committee (URC).

Where a Faculty or UAU seeks an exemption from these protocols, a case must be put to the Academic Senate through Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) or University Research Committee (URC).

6.4 Recording Post-nominals

Post-nominals are not recorded on testamurs or academic transcripts.

7. ORDERING OF QUALIFICATIONS

The conventions for ordering qualifications after a person's name are:

- a) National Honours precede all other qualifications. Example: John Smith OAM, BComm MBA *Bond*, PhD *RMIT*
- b) A lower qualification type normally precedes the higher qualification type. Example: Jane Smith LLB *Bond*, MSc *Melb*; However,
 - Graduate Certificates and Graduate Diplomas are placed after degrees. Example: Jane Brown BCom, MBA *Melb*, DipEd *Latrobe*;
- c) Institution may be displayed in italics and follows academic qualifications. Example: J Smith BBus *RMIT*, MBA *Bond*
- d) Degrees from the same institution are grouped together with a space rather than a comma. Example: John Brown BSc DipA *Melb*, MA *RMIT*
- e) Professional qualifications are placed after academic qualifications. Example: J Smith ActSci, PhD, *Bond*, AIAA
- f) Honours qualifications are placed after the qualification and study descriptor. Example: J Smith MSc(Hons) (Network Systems) or J Smith BInfTech(Hons)
- g) Combined degrees use post-nominals for both programs separated by a comma. Example: J Smith BBus, BHLthSc *Bond*

8. DEFINITIONS, TERMS, ACRONYMS

Abbreviated Title	A field housed within the University's curriculum and enrolment systems used for administrative purposes.
Abbreviation	A shortening of a single word (Refer to Schedule A)
Academic Transcript	An official statement of a student's academic record at the University.
Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF)	The national policy for regulated qualifications in Australian education and training. AQF levels indicate the relative complexity and depth of achievement and the autonomy required to demonstrate that achievement.
AQF qualification	A completed University accredited program of learning that leads to formal certification that a graduate has achieved the learning outcomes as described in the AQF.
Australian Higher Education Graduation Statement (AHEGS)	A supplementary statement to qualification certification documentation that provides information to enhance understanding of the qualification by students, employers, industry, professional associations and internationally. A graduation statement is issued only on award of a qualification.
Award	An AQF qualification conferred by the University upon completion of a coursework program or a program of research.
Award Title	Often referred to as the 'Testamur Title'. The Award Title appears on the Testamur in accordance with the University's Graduation Policy (i.e., the name of the award as recorded on the University Register of Approved Awards and Programs) and the Australian Higher Education Graduate Statement (AHEGS) under 'The Award'. Also refer to Program Title.
Combined degree	An approved combination of two programs at the same level, where, on completion, a student will be conferred with separate awards for both programs.
Coursework program	Any program of study where the assessable content by research represents less than two-thirds of the total assessable content for the program (i.e., a program consisting of 34% or more of coursework studies).
Discipline	Main focus of qualification.
Faculty	Bond Business School, Faculty of Health Sciences & Medicine, Faculty of Law, and Faculty of Society & Design (each of which is headed by an Executive Dean).
Field of Study	Refer to Discipline.
Major	A 'major' sequence typically comprising at least sixty credit points within one discipline area which is offered as part of an undergraduate program; 'double major' means an augmented sequence comprising at least 120 credit points within one area of study.

Minor	A 'minor' sequence typically comprising at least forty credit points within one discipline area which is offered as part of an undergraduate program.
Modifier	A word or words used in a program title that reflect a particular type of AQF qualification, program component, or specialisation.
Postgraduate award	An award of Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma, Masters Degree, or Doctorate.
Post-nominal	A sequence of letters (and sometimes words) constructed from sector recognised and University approved abbreviations which may be displayed after an individual's name to indicate a qualification, professional association membership, or honorary award.
Program Title	Name of the program which appears on the Academic Transcript, and the Australian Higher Education Graduate Statement (AHEGS) under 'Graduates Academic Achievements'. Refer also to Award Title.
Specialisation	A 'specialisation' sequence typically comprising at least 30 credit points with a particular disciplinary focus within one area of study which is offered as part of an undergraduate or postgraduate program.
Student	A person who is enrolled in one or more subjects within an award program or a research program offered by the University.
TEQSA	Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency.
Testamur	An official University-certified legal document provided on the conferral of an award by the University Council at a scheduled University graduation ceremony.
Testamur Title	See Award Title.
Undergraduate award	An award at Diploma, Associate or Bachelor Degree level.
Undergraduate student	A student enrolled in a program that leads to an undergraduate award.
University Academic Unit	Bond University College (headed by the Director) and Transformation CoLab (headed by the Deputy Provost Education).
