Assumed Knowledge

General Electives (5) 50 credit points

Students may choose up to five (5) <u>Undergraduate subjects</u> from any Faculty.

Law Electives (7) 70 credit points

Students must choose seven (7) <u>Undergraduate Law Electives</u> from the Faculty of Law's offerings.**

Law Specialisation - Students may choose to complete an optional Law Specialisation in one of the following areas:

- Canadian Law and Practice
- Corporate and Commercial Law
- Legal Innovation and Technology

- Climate Law Contemporary Legal Issues
- International and Comparative Law
- Legal Practice

To be eligible for a Law Specialisation, students must complete a minimum of four Law Electives (40 credit points) within one of the above areas. Eligible students will receive a Specialisation Certificate at the completion of their program.

Climate Law Major Option

Students may choose to complete an optional Law Major (60cp) in Climate Law.

To be eligible for a Climate Law Major, students must complete a minimum of six (6) Climate Law subjects (60 credit points).**

Legal Innovation and Technology Major Option

Students may choose to complete an optional Law Major (60cp) in Legal Innovation and Technology.

To be eligible for a Legal Innovation & Technology Major, students must complete a minimum of six (6) Legal Innovation & Technology subjects (60 credit points).**
